background. Ivan Komarenko is coming from Poland, Hector Hernandez is Cuban, Shweta Subram - is Indian and Grenville Pinto is of both Italian and Indian descent. Canada is the most multicultural country in the world and each nation is encouraged to celebrate their uniqueness but it's not very often that we have a chance to be a part of an event which showcases a variety of different cultures. That's why Colours of Love is a truly special concert.
